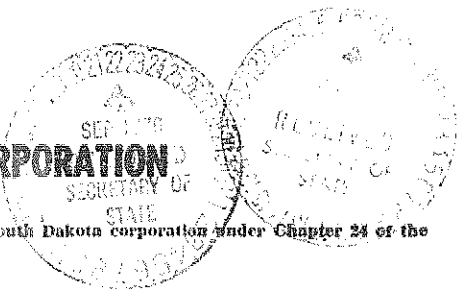

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION



Executed by the undersigned for the purpose of forming a South Dakota corporation under Chapter 24 of the South Dakota Nonprofit Corporation Act.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is Friends of the Music

ARTICLE II

The period of existence is perpetual

ARTICLE III

The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized

The purpose of the Music shall be a non-profit corporation. Its purpose shall be to function as a clearing house for an exchange of information among those interested in South Dakota's musical culture. To that end, it shall encourage the study and performance of the music native to this area.

ARTICLE IV

If the corporation is to have no members, a statement to that effect.

ARTICLE V

If the corporation is to have one or more classes of members, a statement to that effect.

The corporation shall have no classes of members, each membership available at a cost of three (3) dollars per year, except that family membership shall cost five (5) dollars per year.

ARTICLE VI

If the directors are not to be elected or appointed by one or more classes of members, a statement of the manner in which such directors shall be elected or appointed.

The founders of the Friends of the Music shall serve as directors of the corporation for the course of its existence.

ARTICLE VII

Any provisions which the incorporators elect to set forth for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation, including any provision for the distribution of assets on dissolution or final liquidation.

The corporation shall have no by-laws. The full assets of the corporation shall be distributed to the liquidation of its members.

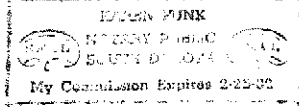

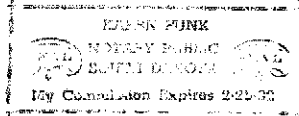

Pursuant to the provisions of SDCL 47-22-19, the undersigned corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is The SOUTH DAKOTA FRIENDS OF OLD TIME MUSIC

SECOND: The following amendment of the Articles of Incorporation was adopted by the directors or members of the corporation on September 23, 1979, in the manner prescribed by SDCL 47-22: amendments to Article 7

The purposes of the organization shall be charitable, religious, and educational within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public offices.

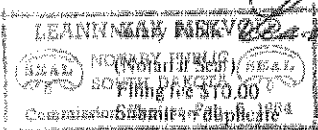

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contribution to which are deductible under Section 170(c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Trustees shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Trustees shall determine. Any of such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court of the county in which the principal purposes or to such organization or organizations as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
